

COMMUNICATION POLICY

Paks II Ltd. (hereinafter: the Company) is a project company established to manage the construction of the new nuclear power plant units at the Paks site, to obtain the necessary preliminary licenses, to implement the project, and subsequently to operate the new units. The Company is committed to continuously informing the public, with particular focus on the following groups:

- The residents of the settlements affected by the project, the construction works, and the future operation of the new nuclear power plant units, as well as the organizations representing them (e.g. municipalities).
- The employees of the Company and professionals working in the nuclear sector, along with their representatives.
- The public in a broad sense (Hungarian citizens and taxpayers).
- Foreign and international stakeholders and organizations involved in the construction and future operation of the new units.

It is our firm conviction that the social acceptance and public support of the Paks II project are of key importance during the implementation of the project. Accordingly, our objective is to provide — while communicating the Company's strategy and corporate values—information related to nuclear energy and the new nuclear power plant units to the public in a credible and professional, yet understandable manner, providing continuous information on the Company's objectives, as well as its short- and long-term benefits (including the current status and milestones of the project, the assurance of energy supply security, and the production of competitively priced, safe- and climate-friendly electricity), and on the national economic significance of the project.

The Company's organizational unit responsible for communications ensures compliance with the applicable laws and the documents defining its operation, as well as compliance with the provisions set out in the communication policy and the disclosure of information. It monitors industry's communications trends, remains open to expanding its range of tools, and participates in international working groups that enhance its effectiveness.

In line with international recommendations, the Company is committed to internal communication that supports a strong nuclear safety culture.

The Company is also committed to responsible external communication; it formulates its messages in a professionally correct, yet understandable and transparent manner, and publishes verified, reliable information about its activities and objectives.
